Devin struggled with a great deal of anger when he started to come to Camp Hope at the age of 7.

He would often take out his anger on family, friends and classmates. As Devin matured, he started to realize that anger was an issue in his life and became concerned how his behaviour was affecting his relationships with friends and family. He often felt alone, discouraged and hopeless. As Community Director in Warden Woods, Julius began a friendship with Devin, and he began to open up to Julius as they would get to know each other by sharing meals together & just hanging out after camp.

"As we journeyed together, I began to learn that Devin's childhood traumas & fears of people disappointing him, would be displayed outwardly through anger. It was evident that Devin needed someone present in his life, who would demonstrate Christ's love and continuously tell him how much Jesus loves him, even in the midst of struggles."

As Julius recalls, "having struggled in the past with aggression myself, I could empathize with him & his frustrations. As I have been able to draw from the strong supporters in my life who showed me the love of Jesus, to show the same kind of love to Devin."

"Devin asked me to be his mentor, and with the help of other UrbanPromise Toronto staff, we have walked alongside him and helped him to cope with his anger. We continue to help by keeping him accountable and show that we're present, like how Jesus was present in my life through my struggles." Devin is currently 17 and is a StreetLeader in the After-School Program, impacting other kids' lives positively by being present in their lives.
