- Collaborate with UPT staff to plan and execute UPT programs.
- Train and coach volunteers and employed young leaders to serve in UPT programs.
- Coordinate mental health support through partnering organizations
- Plan and lead experiential learning retreats, trips, and mission trips.
- Build an Alumni network providing opportunities to be mentors to our young leader and serve their community
- Maintain local partnerships with Churches, community agencies and organizations
